
## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

Your affiant is Detective Greg Martin of the Borough of Berwick Police Department. I have served as a Police Officer since 1999 and have been in my current position as the department criminal investigator since 2012. Before that I served as the departments narcotics investigator and as a supervisor assigned to third shift. I have attended an extensive amount of training in my career which includes, but is not limited to, Homicide Investigations, Sexual Assaults, Crimes against Children, Narcotics Trafficking, Crime Scene Investigations and Evidence Collection. I have served on the Attorney General's Organized Crime and Drug Task Force (OCDTF) and am currently deputized as a Special Deputy United States Marshal to serve on the United States Marshals Fugitive Task Force and serve as a member of the Columbia Montour S.W.A.T. Team. During my career I have authored hundreds of affidavits of probable cause for warrants and criminal complaints resulting in hundreds of arrests and successful prosecutions of criminal offenders.

On November 25th 2017, Detective Brandon Shultz and Sergeant Steve LeVan, were both working the 0700 - 1500 hour shift in full uniform. At approximately 1221 hours both officers responded to a report of an unresponsive 3 year old female at 1126 Freas Avenue 2nd Floor Apartment, Berwick PA 18603. Officers and Berwick Area EMS arrived simultaneously and were directed to a bedroom which is located in the middle of the apartment. In the bedroom lying on the bed, which was a mattress box spring and mattress on the floor, they located the female child, Isabella Brown DOB 03-10-2014. Isabella Brown was found unclothed wet and wrapped in a towel. Isabella Brown was unresponsive and had minimal respirations. Berwick EMS would subsequently provided care for Isabella Brown by aiding her breathing with a bag valve mask. No CPR was performed by EMS.

Detective Shultz spoke to the male caller who made the 911 call reporting the unresponsive 3 year old. The male identified him self as Michael CRIMI DOB [REDACTED] age 19 and provided a Florida drivers license with operator # [REDACTED] and provided a SSN of [REDACTED] and a cell phone number of [REDACTED]. Detective Shultz asked CRIMI if he knew what might have happened to Isabella Brown to be able to assist EMS and hospital staff with the care of Isabella Brown. CRIMI provided the following which is a summary of CRIMI's statement to Detective Shultz: CRIMI is dating the mother of Isabella Brown one Sierra Brown, DOB

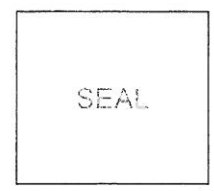

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
## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

██████████ age 18. CRIMI watches Isabella Brown while her mother Sierra Brown works at Amazon in Hazleton during the day. CRIMI works for Pizza Hut in Bloomsburg when Sierra Brown is home with Isabella Brown. CRIMI stated he came home last night ( Friday November 24th 2017) around midnight and did not see the child and felt she probably went to bed at her normal time of 9:00 pm. CRIMI went on stating he woke up because he had an appointment with Lightning Rent-to-Own at approximately 11:00 am for a delivery of a flat screen TV. This would later be verified that Lightning Rent-to-Own was scheduled for a delivery and was at the residence between 10:55 am and 11:34 am. CRIMI stated he was excited about the TV and went in to wake Isabella Brown up to show it to her, but he stated she was unresponsive. CRIMI stated he took her (Isabella Brown) to the bathroom and placed her into the bathtub for approximately 20 minutes trying to wake her. CRIMI stated that was not working so he began to give her CPR because he was taught how to give CPR when he lived in Florida. CRIMI stated that the CPR was not working and then called his mother and then called 911. CRIMI then stated Isabella Brown had fallen 2-3 days prior from a seated position on the toilet striking her head on the bathtub, but that Isabella Brown had seemed normal and okay and had not acted differently from the time she hit her head up until the time he discovered her this morning.

Detective Shultz noted CRIMI was defensive towards him during his attempt to gain information for EMS and Hospital staff for the treatment Isabella Brown.

Detective Shultz followed EMS to the Berwick Hospital where he came into contact with Sierra Brown the mother of Isabella Brown. Detective Shultz spoke with Sierra Brown and what follows is a summary of that conversation: Sierra informed Detective Shultz that Isabella Brown had been vomiting for approximately 3 weeks and had been seen at the Bloomsburg Geisinger Hospital (this was later confirmed to have occurred on November 10th 2017) Isabella Brown was diagnosed with constipation and advised to give Isabella Brown more water. Sierra Brown provided that on Wednesday (November 22nd 2017) she (Sierra Brown) was not home and CRIMI contacted her and informed her that Isabella Brown was sitting on the toilet and then fell into the bathtub striking her head.

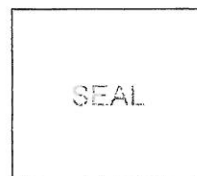


## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

Sierra Brown stated that she had been home all night last night (November 24th 2017) with Isabella Brown and that they did not go to bed until approximately 12:30 am because they were waiting for CRIMI to arrive home from work. Sierra Brown stated that she last saw Isabella Brown this morning (November 25th 2017) at approximately 6:20 am when Sierra Brown left for work. Sierra Brown stated she peaked in to check on Isabella Brown and that when she did Isabella Brown lifted her head and said "I love you mommy" and then laid back down. Sierra Brown stated that Isabella Brown appeared to be normal last night and then again this morning when Sierra Brown left for work.

Detective Shultz viewed multiple bruises on the child at the Hospital and contacted me to informed me of the incident. I immediately responded to the Hospital and found Isabella Brown being attended to and began to photograph Isabella Brown's body which was covered in multiple bruises in various stages of recovery. I took immediate notice of the bruising to both the right and left side of Isabella Browns head and I noted a large red/purple mark on Isabella Brown's left side of her head just behind her left eye above the ear. Isabella Brown was flown to Geisinger Medical Center Danville Pennsylvania for emergency medical care.

Isabella Brown's injuries would again be photographed and documented at Geisinger Medical Center in Danville Pennsylvania. While at Geisinger Medical Center Danville Isabella Brown was seen by multiple physicians one of whom was Dr. Paul Bellino MD.. Dr Bellino would subsequently document, with measurement, 40 bruises and 2 abrasions on Isabella Brown's body in his report. Dr. Bellino's report also states Isabella Brown had retinal hemorrhages, bilateral subdural hematomas with considerable cerebral edema with an impending herniation. The report also indicated that the lesions to both ears as well as the bruises over the forehead are most consistent with someone buffeting Isabella Brown in the head. Dr. Bellino noted that this type of bruising is not seen in usual accidental injuries and that the bruise over the inner aspect of the right leg appeared to be a pattern bruise from an apparent finger most likely caused by a glancing blow of a hand. As part of Dr. Bellino's assessment he conferred with Dr. Thomas W Wilson of Ophthalmology. Dr Wilson's diagnosis was Bilateral Retinal hemmorrhages consistent with non-accidental trauma. As part of Isabella Brown's treatment Dr. Bellino spoke to both mother Sierra Brown and to Michael

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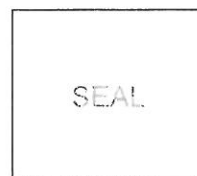

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## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

CRIMI, Sierra Brown's live in boyfriend. Both gave statements to Dr. Bellino that were consistent with their individual statements provided to first responding officers.


On November 28th 2017 Isabella Brown was pronounced dead at 12:44 pm by Montour County Coroner Scott Lynn. The cause of death listed on the Certificate of Death is listed as Multiple Blunt Force Injuries.

On December 1st 2017 an autopsy was conducted on Isabella Brown at the Lehigh Valley Medical Center which I attended. The injuries that Isabella Brown sustained were all documented, examined and photographed. The full medical examiners report is not available at this time, however, will be made part of this investigation at a later date. Among all of the injuries sustained a large hemorrhage just under the scalp on the left side was visible, I would later have the opportunity to view this injury on the CT scan taken of Isabella Brown when she was treated on the 25th of November and then was shown a comparison of a CT scan that was conducted on the 10th of November of Isabella Brown for an illness that was unrelated to her injuries. The medical examiner conducting the autopsy offered that the injuries that Isabella sustained to her retinas and brain were not accidental trauma and that the lesions to the ears were non accidental.

On December 6th 2017 I met with Dr Bellino at Geisigner Medical Center Danville. Dr. Bellino was able to show me the side by side comparison of Isabella Brown's two CT scans the one from November 10th 2017 and the one from November 25th 2017. This showed the injury to the left side of Isabella Brown's head. Dr. Bellino was also able to say that due to the amount of injury he witnessed to Isabella Brown's brain she suffered a concussive event which would have lead to a rapid loss of neurological function, altered breathing, impaired vision and unconsciousness all of which would have occurred over a short time span.

On November 25th Sierra Brown, while at the Berwick Hospital, was asked who lived in the home at 1126 Freas Avenue 2nd Floor Berwick PA 18603. Brown indicated that only she, Michael CRIMI and Isabella Brown resided at that location. Brown was also asked who provided care for Isabella Brown. Sierra Brown indicated that when she worked Michael CRIMI would watch Isabella Brown until she returned home and then Michael

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
## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

CRIMI would go to work. Sierra Brown was asked if anyone else had provided care for Isabella brown in the past several weeks. Sierra Brown could only offer that Isabella Brown had stayed with her biological fathers parents once over night on a weekend in that time frame.

On December 11th 2017 I interviewed Sierra Brown with her father present and recorded the interview. What follows is a summary of that interview: Sierra Brown again confirmed that only Michael CRIMI and Sierra Brown had provided care for Isabella Brown in the past week. That Sierra Brown had begun to notice bruises on Isabella Brown recently. Sierra Brown had been home alone with Isabella Brown on Friday November 24th 2017 all day and night and that Isabella Brown acted normal and had been awake until approximately 12:30 am until Michael CRIMI had returned home from work. Sierra Brown woke up on the 25th of November 2017 and left for work at her normal time approximately 6:20 am to go to work and that as usual she looked in on Isabella Brown before leaving. Sierra Brown again stated that when she looked in on Isabella Brown. Isabella Brown lifted her head and said " I love you Mommy, Bye" and Sierra left for work. Sierra Brown was asked as to the where abouts of Michael CRIMI, she stated that he left with his parents on December 4th 2017 prior to Isabella Browns' memorial service, but that CRIMI has continued to contact her via text message. Sierra Brown was then requested to take a Polygraph examination to further validate her account of the facts as she had reported them to me. The Polygraph was conducted at the Pennsylvania State Police Barracks Bloomsburg by Trooper Allen Pietkiewicz. At the conclusion of that examination, Trooper Pietkiewicz contacted me and informed me that Sierra Brown showed no signs of deception in her statement to law enforcement regarding this investigation.
